## Load in your Vehicle First – Unload Last at the Event

<b>1st</b>	SCRAP METAL, APPLIANCES	Barbecues, microwaves, cast iron sinks and tubs, dishwashers, lawnmowers, stoves, hot water heaters, washers & dryers.	No cars, trailers, greasy metal.	Please drain all liquids, “(gas, oil, etc.)” and remove any plastic or rubber from metal.
<b>2nd</b>	ELECTRONICS, TV’S & PHONES	Computers, monitors, laptops, keyboards, scanners, printers, fax and power supplies	No Mice Accepted	Free to recycle year-round through E-Cycle Washington 1-800-RECYCLE 
<b>3rd</b>	FRIDGE, FREEZERS AND AIR CONDITIONER	Household Fridge, freezers and AC units	No commercial appliances or auto air conditioning units	
<b>4<sup>TH</sup></b>	PROPANE TANKS, AND PORCELAIN	Toilets, sinks & ceramic tiles	No commercial appliances or automobile air conditioning units.	No Mattresses or box springs accepted this year.
<b>5<sup>th</sup></b>	BATTERIES – LEAD ACID AND HOUSEHOLD / ALKALINE BATTERIES	Car, truck, marine lead acid batteries. Pre-sort large quantities; Household alkaline batteries		“Rechargeable batteries can be recycled for free at Issaquah Home Depot or Lowes or listings at <a href="http://www.call2recycle.org">www.call2recycle.org</a> .”
<b>6th</b>	FLUORESCENTS – BULBS AND TUBES	Limit of 10 per household per day.	No lighting fixtures or broken tubes.	Double bagged please. Free to recycle 10 bulbs/day year- round, check. <a href="http://www.lightrecycle.org">www.lightrecycle.org</a> or 1-800-RECYCLE.
<b>7th</b>	PETROLEUM PRODUCTS	Motor oil, transmission & brake fluid, antifreeze and oil filters.	No Diesel, no 2-cycle mix, no kerosene, No spent gasoline. No unmarked or mixed liquids. Household Hazardous-Wastemobile can accept these items.	Do not mix liquids together. Containers must be properly sealed. Must take container with you. Unaccepted items can be taken to the Household Hazardous-Wastemobile.
<b>8th</b>	TIRES	On or off rim passenger car, light truck, and motorcycle tires ONLY.	No Heavy Truck or Commercial Tires.	Biased, steel-belted & studded tires accepted; Maximum 10 per household.
<b>Load Last</b>	CLOTHING & HOUSEHOLD ITEMS	Reusable items that work: clothing, shoes, bedding, pots, books, small appliances, & toys.	No broken or wet items. No furniture, carpet, mattresses or box springs. Stained or torn clothes and linens are OK.	Stained, torn, or badly worn textiles can be recycled through Threadcycle. Visit <a href="http://www.kingcounty.gov/threadcycle">www.kingcounty.gov/threadcycle</a>

**PLEASE DO NOT BRING:** any household paint, pesticides, or household chemicals – take to the Snoqualmie/North Bend **Household Hazardous Wastemobile**, at the **Cascade View Elementary School, June 28-30, 2019, 10am-5pm**. LATEX paint must be dried out & put in the garbage with lid off.
